Community to Community Development will be attending the
Bellingham City Council meeting tonight to demand the city divests \$70
MILLION FROM US BANK.

EVEN MORE IMPORTANT IS THE ORDINANCE THE CITY HAS PROPOSED AND PUBLISHED A DRAFT, STATING BELLINGHAM WILL BE A SANCTUARY CITY. WE UNDERSTAND THE TRUTH OF THE ORDINANCE TO BE NOT NEARLY ENOUGH. HOW IT IS JUST A STATUS QUO REENFORCEMENT ON THE CITY'S PART. THIS DENIAL OF TRUE HELP FOR IMMIGRANTS AND AFFECTED PEOPLES IN OUR HOME WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. C2C HAS A PROPOSED ORDINANCE PROTECTING WORKERS AND FAMILIES WHICH THE CITY WILL RESPECT.
